An unusually big field for this event but also a sub-standard edition of the Middle Park. I suspect most of those in the top half on this results sheet will be struggling in 2012. The best of them because they will be aimed to highly after having run "well" in a Group 1, , the others because they will begin their 3yo campaign on a high handicap mark.

CRUSADE	1	Very attractive colt with scope, very shiny coat, very relaxed, went down really well to the start (much the same as when he was 4 th in the Someville Tattersall here two weeks ago). Incredibly, this son of Mr Greeley was pre-entered for the Horses in Training Sales here later in the month, but he is now heading to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) at Churchill Downs, where I very much doubt that he will make an impact.
Lilbourne Lad	2	Very fit, relatively light, looks to have little scope, will be wisely retired to stud but may go to the Breeders' Cup for one more run.
Reply	3	<u>Very</u> fit, small but good sort, relaxed in preliminaries.
Balty Boys	4	Has scope for improvement and that came about here, was a little nervous in the paddock and free going down to post. >>>

A better field than for the Middle Park but this was also a sub-standard cediton of a G1 that has a history of throwing up future stars.. With two Irish trained colts filling the first two places this result was another knock on the British juvenile division. We will probably need to look to once or twice raced maiden winners, to find d those most likely to make an impact in classic races next year, Harbour Watch is the only Group winning colt that has really impressed me this year.

PARISH HALL	1	Shiny, attractive, strong colt with scope, very fit, bright and alert in paddock, went down well to the start.
Power	2	Very fit, very relaxed, mature, went down well to the start.
Most Improved	3	Dappled out coat and looked well, fit (but not very), quite relaxed in the paddock but was a bit keen to post. Interesting for 2012.

I would take Most Improved to beat Parish Hall and Power next year, and Skybet offer **40-1** about Brian Meehan's colt for the 2,000 Guineas. That looks too big to me (others are as short as 16/1).

Red Duke	8	<u>Very</u> fit, fully exposed, pulled hard going down to post. Probably done.
Ektihaam	L	Big, tall, strong, plenty of scope, immature going down to post. Ektihaam was 4-1 in the early betting but went right out to 8-1. His trainer had mentioned the Autumn Stakes as a preferred target.

NEW NOTEBOOK HORSE: MOST IMPROVED (for 2012)

4.25 **Rockfel Stakes (G2) 2yo fillies 7 furlongs**

The Aidan O'Brien trained winner Wading, flagged up as 25-1 ante-post for next year's Oaks, was easy to back at 5-1 in the morning but soon dropped and was well supported inside the last half-hour of the race.

WADING	1	Very fit. Relatively small, very relaxed / mature in preliminaries. Was brought early into the pre-parade ring.
Pimpernel	2	Was also brought early into the pre-parade ring, but in her case that was probably not such a good idea, as she was quite edgy and nervous. She is a nice sort, still growing, and very fit, perhaps she has been asked a bit too much to soon in her career, but she ends her 2yo campaign with a progressive form curve.
Gray Pearl	3	Has some scope, growing, bandaged front legs.
Bana Wu	4	Notebook runner, EW bet at 50-1 and just fell short of delivering a profit for us. Still a maiden but that can't last long. Shiny, attractive, scopey filly, very fit, relaxed. Type to make a nice 3yo and bred to stay. Bana Wu comes from the family of Oaks winner Ramruma.
Sunday Times	5	Attractive, fit, has scope, little bit immature but went down really well.
Janey Muddles	6	Small, neat, very shiny, fit, quite relaxed.
Mary Fildes	7	Shiny, very fit, immature, 2 handlers in paddock, has some scope.
Regal Realm	8	Very fit, small, had some tough races, probably done.
Alsindi	L	Most disappointing two weeks after her fine win here, seemed lighter but nothing in the paddock indicated she would run badly, bandaged behind.

Bred to be a Derby horse and still worth adding to our Notebook horses.
Whip Rule	4	Attractive colt with some scope but does not look potentially top class.
Validus	5	Attractive colt with scope, shiny coat, growing, was a little bit nervous.
Swing Alone	6	Very shiny, very fit, immature / nervous, 2 handlers, has scope.
Moon Pearl	7	Attractive, very nice gelding with scope, from the family of Miesque. Finished just 1 ¼ lengths behind Reply in valuable sales race at Doncaster (see Sep 8 Report) but disappointed here.

SAMITAR <i>1 ¼ lengths</i>	1	She had the form in the book, having run second in the Cheveley Park a week ago (see Sep 23 report). Very fit, relaxed, free to post. This small filly has made a bit of a name for herself now but I will be amazed if she is up to being competitive at G1 level next year.
Hazel Lavery	2	Good sort, fit, quite relaxed pre-parade ring and paddock but pulled going down to the start.
Glee	3	Very shiny, very fit, relaxed, went down well 2 nd to Wahylah here two weeks ago - see Sep 17 Report
Tina's Spirit	4	Very fit, very small filly, no scope.
Arsaadi	5	Recommended EW at 20-1. Plenty of scope, best looking filly in this paddock, also seemed positive going down to the start. She had run well behind Kinetica and subsequent G1 winner Elusive Kate in LR / G3 events on her two previous starts and may have found the ground a bit too firm here. I still think she is the best prospect in this field.
