

GLOBEFORM ANALYSIS

REAGAN'S FLAME is the best horse in this field, and she's **way too big at 8-1 on the morning line**. The daughter of War Command has not raced since tiring to be last of six in the Pippin Stakes on dirt at Oaklawn Park in December, but her two runs prior, in strong allowance heats on turf; were very good performances. Plenty good enough to make her the one to beat here. She ran to GF 102 when beating Mallemoo by 3/4 length over 8.5 furlongs at Keeneland in October, and improved to **Globeform 104** when beaten a length in second behind Stylish Sue over the the same distance at Churchill Downs a month later. Mallemoo franked the Keeneland form by running a good second to Oversubscribed in the Forever Together Stakes at Aqueduct on her next outing - and Reagan's Flame's form at Churchill Downs has also been backed up since. The winner Stylish Sue was last behind Proctor Street in the Cardinal Stakes three weeks later but note that Adrasteia, who was third behind Stylish Sue and Reagan's Flame, took fourth in the Cardinal and has since been third to Speed Shopper in the Florence Stakes at Turfway Park. Speed Shopper went from that race to success also in the more prestigious Christophe Clement Stakes at Gulfstream Park.

This will be Reagan's Flame's first try on Tapeta and her first start for trainer Martin Drexler, who has enjoyed a lot of success running horses over the synthetics. A runner with good tactical speed, efficient when part of the pace or just off the pace, Reagan's Flame is a half-sister to O'Malley; a winner on turf who was placed on the synthetic track at Presque Isle Downs. Drexler has an excellent record with horses having their first outing since joining his team and his layoff stats are also strong. So much points to Reagan's Flame; she has the best form in the book, her running style makes her a perfect fit and this is her best best distance; at 8-1 she really is a must bet in this handicap. Even half that price would be good value. >>>

TABLE FLIRT, a versatile filly who is as good on dirt as she is on turf (so why not Tapeta?), ran to GF 99p when second to Velvet Vortex over a mile on the main track at Saratoga last June, and improved to **Globeform 100** with a game off-the-pace win against subsequent winner Golden Sunshine over 8.5 furlongs on turf at Churchill Downs in September. Stepped sharply up in class in the Mrs. Revere over the same trip two months later, Table Flirt went off at 30-1 and finished second last, 4 lengths behind Lush Lips. That run was better than it looks on paper and Table Flirt is also **overpriced as a 6-1 chance** on the morning line. She is good enough to beat most of these, though one thing that may count against her is a lack of pace.

MISS MARY NELL was an upset winner of a handicap covering 1m 70yds on the Tapeta on Pegasus day, when she raced prominently throughout with a low weight and beat Warming by 3/4 length. **FANTASY PERFORMER**, who ran better when beating **CHARLIE'S WISH** by a head in another handicap, run over 9 furlongs, on the Tapeta three weeks earlier, checked in fourth 3 1/4 lengths behind Miss Mary Nell. These both have good recent form and they like this surface, but would they be capable of matching strides with the horses Reagan's Flame has been competitive against? Miss Mary Nell moved up to **Globeform 97** last time out, while Fantasy Performer's career best, **Globeform 100**, was recorded when she ran second to G3 winner Tax Implications over 8.5 furlongs / turf at Saratoga last August.

CHARLIE'S WISH is now 2lbs better off against **FANTASY PERFORMER**, who beat her by a head when they met over 9 furlongs at this track on New Year's day; thus she has a chance of turning the form around. She returned **Globeform 100** then - though was well below that level when beating just one home as a 33-1 chance in the much more competitive Endeavour Stakes at Tampa Bay Downs some four weeks later.

QUEENS COMMAND, like Reagan's Flame trained by Martin Drexler, also has form good enough to be considered by Trifecta players. She disappointed in the My Charmer Stakes at Turfway Park in December, but had performed to **Globeform 98** when beaten just a hard fought head by Sultana in the 10-furlong Maple Leaf Stakes on Tapeta at Woodbine in November. Queens Command has a turf win over 8.5 furlongs so cutting back in distance is hardly an issue.

CONCLUSION: A straight win bet on Reagan's Flame is one of the priorities this weekend, particularly if she were to go off at anything like her **8-1 morning line** odds. A hedge second bet is also tempting, given that Table Flirt is as big as **6-1**. These two have done well in better company than they are facing here, and it seems that locals overestimate recent Tapeta form; something that influences bettors and line makers alike. Trifecta players may still be scratching their heads though, as it's hard to rule anyone out of that picture. The best way to go is to lean on Reagan's Flame on top with Table Flirt in 2nd or 3rd and the others mixed in. That strategy gets us a plan with just 10 lines. **276-1 TRIFECTA HIT WITH 10 LINES**
