GLOBEFORM ANALYSIS

PROCTOR STREET should be even money for this race, not 2-1 as the morning line states. True, she was well below her true form last time out but that's a run to ignore; and any of her three preceding performances were good enough to beat these rivals. She was badly hampered on the first turn in the De La Rose Stakes at Saratoga in July, an incident that caused her to be very lit up and pulling. She ended up at the back of the field and never got into the race. Tyler Gaffalione accepted the situation and let her coast home in second last. Proctor Street had hit the board in 10 of her 12 starts up to that event.

She was coming off three good placed efforts, most recently as she was beaten half a length by Sweet Treasure in the Mint Julep Stakes over 8.5 furlongs at Churchill Downs in late May, when she came with her customary stretch run from just off the pace but just fell short. Her preceding run, a good second behind subsequent Diana Stakes winner Kathynmarissa and Gezora in the 9-furlong Modesty Stakes represents better form. Beaten 1 1/2 lengths, she improved to **Globeform 110** on that occasion. The daughter of Street Sense had returned GF 108p when winning the Cardinal Stakes over the same distance at Churchill Downs in November '25, where she came with a determined finish from off the pace to beat Awesome Czech by 3/4 length. That was Proctor Street's last outing in 2025, when she won three of her five races.

Her overall record spells consistency, though she did disappoint in the Pegasus World Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Gulfstream Park in January. She had a good trip but never picked up when asked and came home in eighth place, 4 3/4 lengths behind Destino d'Oro, who beat her also when they met in the Hillsborough Stakes at Tampa Bay Downs in March, though this time only by a neck from Proctor Street. Proctor Street's bad run in the 'Pegasus' must have been an off-day. She has always been very game and reliable, and she bounced right back to such consistency with three good runs afterwards. The Brendan Walsh trainee ran well also when third a length behind G1 winner Dynamic Pricing in the Perfect Sting Stakes over a mile at Saratoga's inner track last August - and she should have no problems handling the inner at Woodbine. With just two of her six rivals in the Canadian likely to go forward, we may not see a particularly strong pace here - and that should suit Proctor Street, who likes to be ridden just off the speed.

QUEENS COMMAND ran her best race to date when producing **Globeform 102** to get fourth, 2 lengths behind Sweet Rebecca, in the Sand Springs Stakes over 8.5 furlongs at Gulfstream Park in March; and she was close to that level also when taking a big step up in class in the 9-furlong Modesty Stakes at Churchill Downs in May. She finished last of eight but was not at all disgraced, passing the winning post 6 lengths behind Kathynmarissa, who has since won the Diana at Saratoga. **PROCTOR STREET** ran third 4 1/2 lengths in front of her. Queens Command tried 12 furlongs in the Keertana Stakes three weeks later but that did not work out (distant seventh). She ran better when dropped back to a mile in allowance company at Ellis Park in July, though her fifth placed finish behind Bourbon Memory there was also some way off her best. Having run second to Sultana in the Maple Leaf Stakes over 8.5 furlongs on the Tapeta track at Woodbine last year, Queens Command is well known to Canadian racing fans and she might get some attention; but her most recent results are not all that inspiring.

LUPA, a lightly raced 4yo representing high percentage trainer Joise Carroll, is more interesting. Perfectly drawn by the rail, with no other speed directly to her outside, this effective front-runner will probably get a very good trip. She almost managed to go gate to wire in the 9-furlongs Trillium Stakes on the Tapeta track here at Woodbine in July, when Fantastical pipped her by a head in an exciting finish where Fortyfiveseventy was just another head behind in third place. As on her previous start, Lupa pulled quite hard on the lead, but she completed the race well; and was actually flicking her ears passing the winning post. There's likely more to come from this runner. Fantastical was coming off a good second to Shifty in the Royal North Stakes a month earlier. Lupa improved to **Globeform 101p** in the Trillium, which was her second start in 2026. She made all to take a decent allowance heat over 8.5 furlongs on the same track in June, winning straight off the bench after a seven-month layoff. This daughter of Lope de Vega has 3 wins from 7 starts and she was racing over 8.5 furlongs on the inner course when breaking her maiden on her debut last year. Going back to the lawn should not be an issue and cutting half a furlong back in distance will suit her well. The day she learns to settle better she will improve her rating. Note that she had post one also in her two previous races this year. >>>

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EPONINE has made two starts in 2026; both came at Saratoga and they were good efforts - almost as good as her best form in France last year. The 4yo daughter of Tamayuz was edgy before each race but it didn't seem to affect her performances. She ran second, beaten a neck by Marketplaceofideas, in an 8.5-furlong allowance race on the outer course in early June; then won a similar contest over a mile on the inner course a month later, when she beat Accent by a length, with Bourbon Betty a close third. Eponine came from just off the pace in these races, returning GF 99 and GF 100. Bought privately by Repole Stables in France, she is expected to turn the investment into graded stakes success in North America, and she gets her first chance here. She's won three times and been off the board just twice from nine outings to date. Progressing nicely in the spring and early summer of '25, she was runner-up in two good mile races at Chantilly, most notably in the Prix de Sandringham (a race often contested by fillies coming out of the French 1,000 Guineas) where she improved to **Globeform 103**. Eponine was prominently ridden in the Sandringham and, although she could not match the one-length winner Godspeed, she kept on gamely to fill the exacta a length in front of the English trained Betty Clover. Godspeed had previously run third to G1 winner Zarinaga in a G3 and she went on to finish fourth in the G1 Prix Rothschild, beaten 2 1/2 lengths behind multiple G1 winner Fallen Angel. Prior to the Prix de Sandringham, Eponine had lost the Prix de Lilas by just a neck to American Gal - and that filly ran second in a G3 event at Ascot two starts later.

UPDATE AUG 15 Majaz, who was a neck behind **POWER OF DESTINY** in July, franked the form by running third behind Midnight Concerto and Tulip at Saratoga on Thursday; this happened in a race where Make You Mine and Special Wood (4th and 6th behind **EPONINE** last time out) both disappointed. Eponine's rating still stays the same, while Power of Destiny's win has been upgraded to Globeform 100, making her a C-horse in the Canadian. Her form was also given a mild boost when Veery (third in the July race) was a close third (but disqualified) in a similar contest at Woodbine on Friday.

Also note that Tulip's good run at Saratoga was nice boost to King's Plate favorite **LUSTER**, who beat her by 7 1/2 lengths when they met in the Selene Stakes at Woodbine in June.

CONCLUSION: Proctor Street looks a banker in this race and let's hope we see odds close to her 2-1 morning line. It would be good value. Eponine and Lupa are obvious B-horses but it's impossible to pick one over the other. Eponine was Group placed in Europe and she's coming off a smooth win at Saratoga, though the two board hitters behind her both lack good recent form. Lupa is the untapped potential with home court advantage and a favorable draw. These three stand out from the rest, with the C-horses being Power of Destiny (form recently boosted; see above) and Queens Command; she has been just as good as the two B-horses in the past and a return to form would make her a Trifecta contender.
