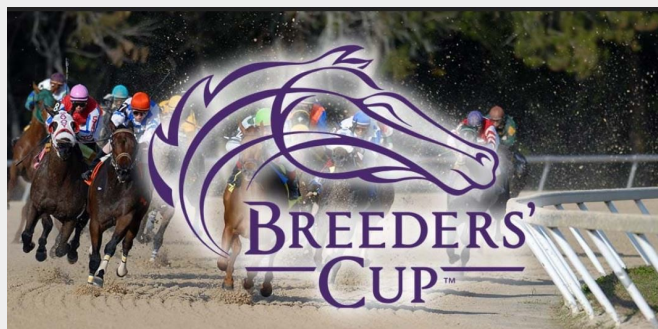

GLOBEFORM ANALYSIS

PHAROAH'S WINE, who broke her maiden going a mile here at Kentucky Downs as a juvenile, is coming out of a key race that has worked out incredibly well; having been beaten just a head by Simply In Front in the Kentucky Downs Preview Ladies Turf Mile at Ellis Park in early August. A slow start put her further back than how she had raced on previous starts, but she travelled sweetly throughout and finished well from off the pace - advancing in tandem with Simply In Front, who won the photo finish. Amber Cascade, also coming from the back ran a dead heat with Pharoah's Wine for second, while **WAVES OF MISCHIEF** was a close fourth. This was Pharoah's Wine's best performance to date and the form has been well advertised in recent days. Simply In Front went on to be a good runner-up, beaten just 3/4 length by top sprinter Ag Bullet, in the Kentucky Downs Ladies Turf Sprint on Saturday; and on the same day Amber Cascade took second behind Bellezza in the Flower Bowl at Aqueduct. Pharoah's Wine looked really well in the preliminaries at Ellis Park, and she improved to **Globeform 109**, having run to GF 106 on both of her two preceding starts. She is clearly thriving and, with good recent form and course experience, she looks a very strong contender for this race. **Morning line 8-1** looks too big. >>>

VIVE VEUVE is also coming off a career best, **Globeform 107p**, and she looks the type to improve again. She ran second to **PHAROAH'S WINE** over a mile at Churchill Downs in May, beaten 2 1/4 lengths after making up ground from the rear of the field, and she has won her two race since in good style. The step up to 8.5 furlongs suited her well when she ran out an easy 2 3/4-length winner from Proctor Street four weeks later (also at Churchill Downs), and she followed up with another smooth win at Saratoga in August. By that time, Proctor Street had beaten G3 winner Tax Implications to capture a stakes quality allowance heat and Vive Veuve was a popular even money favorite at the Spa; she did not disappoint. Once more tackling 8.5 furlongs she came with a nice turn of foot from off the pace and won by 2 1/4 lengths from Immensitude (who has 2lbs less on her back), with Do Gooder back in third place. Immensitude was runner-up to the smart filly Kathrynmarissa and Do Gooder won an allowance sprint at Kentucky Downs last week. Vive Veuve is a progressive sort. A neat and well balance horse, she ran third in the Music City Stakes here at Kentucky Downs last year; she has an obvious chance.

SPARKLE BLUE put together two good runs in the spring of 2024, when she made all to win the Hillsborough Stakes over 9 furlongs at Tampa Bay Downs (beating G1 winner Aspen Grove by half a length) and came from off the pace to finish second behind Fast as Flight in the Modesty Stakes over the same distance at Churchill Downs. Both of those runs were worth **Globeform 109**. Sparkle Blue has been a bit below that level in 2025 but she signaled a possible return to form when fourth in the Anchorage Stakes over 9 furlongs at Ellis Park in late June, and she has been rested since. The daughter of Hard Spun was a well beaten fourth to Walkathon in the Ladies Turf Stakes over a mile at Kentucky Downs last year. Course experience is good but one thing that counts against Sparkle Blue is today's distance; she is better suited by further than a mile.

GRAYOSH ran her best race to date when winning the Lake Placid Stakes over 8.5 furlongs at Saratoga last year and she was close to that level when beaten just a neck into third place behind her barnmate Segesta in the 9-furlong Matchmaker Stakes at Monmouth Park in July. Having produced **Globeform 108** in the Lake Placid, she ran to GF 106 at Monmouth, where she was doing her best work coming from the back in the closing stages. Segesta did the form no harm when second half a length behind the favorite Special Wan in the Ladies Turf Stakes at Kentucky Downs on Saturday, and Grayosh is interesting here. She cuts back in distance but has she has won twice over 8.5 furlongs and the Lake Placid was run on the inner course at Saratoga; she probably won't be inconvenienced by the distance here and if she handles the undulations she can make an impact.

WAVES OF MISCHIEF improved to **Globeform 104** when fourth, beaten just a neck by Simply In Front, in the Kentucky Downs Preview Ladies Turf Mile at Ellis Park, where **PHAROAH'S WINE** finished second. Waves of Mischief raced prominently all the way and she kept on well to the wire, but she is as much as 8lbs worse off against Pharoah's Wine this time and may find it hard to make an impact. Recent form matter though, and she is a horse to use underneath in the Tri plans. >>>

NO MO CANDY, yet another exiting a career best, is a possible pace setter under Irad Ortiz Jr (who seems confident that he will be fit to ride after the Jockey Club Gold Cup accident); she has been showing improvement through her three starts this year, most recently when third to Ozara in the Ballston Spa Stakes over 8.5 furlongs at Saratoga in August. A moderate pace would give her a chance of hitting the board. She has also been entered for the Ladies Marathon on Saturday but reports suggest that she will run here.

CONCLUSION: Two names stand out; the 5-2 favorite Vive Veuve and the **overpriced 8-1 shot Pharoah's Wine**. It's too simplistic to assume that the latter would have won with a better start at Ellis last time out but giving away ground is never a good thing, particularly for a horse that prefers to be sitting just off the pace, and she's the value bet. What odds would she be if she had won that race? Talking of pace; with No Mo Candy and Waves of Mischief in the mix we should see at least honest fractions, something that will also suit Vive Veuve. There's a good chance that one of these two will win and the other one will be hitting the board; in other words this is an opportunity for a Tri plan where the fillers are the four others in the selection box.
