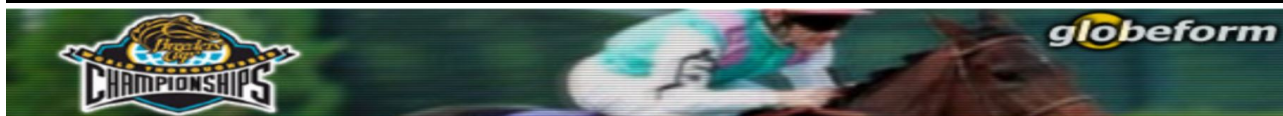

Globeform value bet: Gezora 10-1 / B Cup Filly & Mare Turf

Having already backed She Feels Pretty at 8-1 for this race last week (she is now 3-1 and 4-1 with most bookmakers), we can - and should - add another Filly & Mare Turf horse to our future bet portfolio, namely the French trained Gezora, one of the best 10 to 12-furlong fillies in Europe. It was confirmed yesterday that she will be heading to the Breeders' Cup, and Boylesport offer a standout **10-1** about this filly. Other firms have her at 8-1 and 9-1, which is also great value.

Gezora was last seen in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, where she had a bad draw (13), ended up too far back in the field from the outset and was unplaced, beaten 10 3/4 lengths behind her top class stable companion Daryz on very soft ground. The race was dominated by horses that had been prominent or ridden just off the pace, and Gezora's last run is best forgotten. She actually performed a lot better than the result might suggest, and one good thing to take from the outing was that she did not have a hard race. This is not the best of comparisons, but her run at Longchamp reminded me a little bit of Daylami's attempt at winning the Arc back in 1999. He too struggled to get involved (on unsuitably heavy ground), was eased and passed the winning post in ninth place, 23 lengths behind the winning favorite Montjeu. A month later Daylami won the Breeders' Cup Turf on good ground at Gulfstream Park.

Gezora had won on heavy ground prior to the Arc, but that was as a 2yo and her best form this year has come on good to soft ground. She may encounter firm ground at Del Mar, and that's an unknown, but this filly produced a nice turn of foot when winning the French Oaks, and she has never looked the type who absolutely needs give underfoot to be efficient.

She is already proven against older rivals, having run second to Aventure in the Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September, beaten 1 1/2 lengths. Aventure is the best older filly in France; she ran second in the Arc last year (but bounced in this year's edition) and has solid G1 form overall.

Gezora was visually impressive when capturing the Prix de Diane (French Oaks) over 10.5 furlongs at Chantilly in June. She did not beat proper G1 performers that day but she was much the best as she quickened past rivals inside the final furlong, beating Bedtime Story by a length. Three subsequent stakes winners have come out of the race. Given a traditional French Arc prep, ie a break right through the summer, she was coming off a near three-month rest in the Vermeille, where she was an eye catching runner-up closing in sharply at the finish. She looks sure to improve and she should definitely not be a 10-1 shot; owned by Peter Brant, Gezora is a leading contender for the BC Filly & Mare Turf.

TURF SPRINT: STARLUST 30-1 is too high; on his day this 3yo is one of the best turf sprinters in Europe, he ran well at the Breeders' Cup last year so we know he handles the turn, and he is well drawn.

Starlust won at 34-1 (he was 40-1 with some bookmakers)

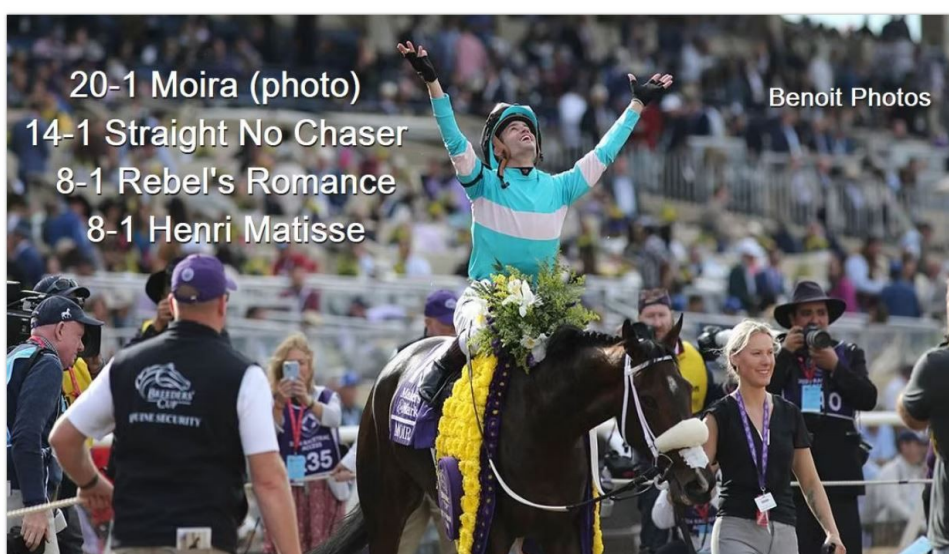
MILE: MORE THAN LOOKS 20-1 is too big; this lightly raced 4yo has been campaigned with one race and one race only in mind this season; the BC Mile, and he ran an excellent second to Carl Spackler at Keeneland, beaten just a length after a strong finish, so 20-1 makes little sense about this horse.

More Than Looks won at 7-1 (he was 20-1 with most bookmakers)
