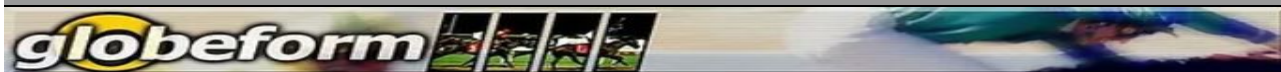

Globeform ratings are expressed in pounds. The **"Rank"** column shows the horse best in at the weights based on Globeform ratings on top, with other horses ranked down in pounds. For example; rank figure 6 tells us that the horse is 6lbs below the top ranked horse. Length values: 5-6 furlongs: 3lbs per length. 7 fur: 2.5lbs. 8 - 11 fur: 2lbs. 12 fur: 1.5lbs

GLOBEFORM ANALYSIS

STELLIFY won this event last year and she will probably be hard to deny as she goes for repeat success in the 10.5-furlong race. She was below par in fourth place, 2 1/2 lengths behind favorite Gimme A Nother in the Beverly D Stakes at Colonial Downs in August, but it was her first run since the 2025 Breeders' Cup, she may not have been fully fit and she was not given a positive ride that day. She met much better rivals in 11-furlong Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Del Mar last November, when she ran a respectable race to finish seventh, 5 lengths behind the high class French winner Gezora. Stellify returned GF 106 at Del Mar, having produced **Globeform 111p** when winning the Ladies Marathon over 10.5 furlongs at Kentucky Downs two months earlier. That was her fourth straight win and it came on the back of an impressive allowance success over 12 furlongs at the same course just nine days earlier. The daughter of Justify had gone gate to wire over 11 furlongs at Churchill Downs in June, and the same tactics were employed in her races at Kentucky Downs. She ran out an easy 2 3/4-length winner in the Ladies Marathon, where **WAY TO BE MARIE** filled second, 3/4 in front of Miwa, who was also coming off an impressive win over the course nine days earlier. Stellify has good tactical speed, she races with great zest and she stays well. If back to something like her best she will take all the beating here.

PIN UP BETTY also ran in the Beverly D Stakes, but failed to fire and was beaten 7 lengths to finish second last in the nine-runner field. It was her only poor run for a very long time. This mare has been remarkably consistent over the past two seasons and perhaps something was amiss at Colonial Downs. She became back-to-back winner of the race when taking the 9-furlong Anchorage Stakes at Churchill Downs in late June. Having been a bit below her best in three previous runs this year (though raced respectably), she bounced right back to **Globeform 109**, a rating the daughter of Constitution produced twice in 2025, the first time when winning the Anchorage. She is a very game and genuine performer. This year's Anchorage success was gained with a solid 2-length verdict over **WAY TO BE MARIE**, who also failed to show her true colors in the Beverly D (well beaten sixth). They both came from off the pace in the Anchorage, with Pin Up Betty always looking the stronger of the two. Warming, who checked in third half a length behind Way To Be Marie, was coming off a win in the Gallorette Stakes on Laurel Park's Preakness day; and she went on to win the Yellow Ribbon Stakes at Del Mar next time out. Pin Up Betty has been operating in races from 8 to 9 furlongs; her running style suggested that another half-furlong would not be a problem in the Beverly D but perhaps it was. Stamina could be an issue; which is why **WAY TO BE MARIE** is taken to beat her this time. She is 2lbs better off at the weights and she is proven over this course and distance, having produced a career best **Globeform 106** when runner-up to **STELLIFY** twelve months ago. Way to Be Marie is **way to big at 10-1** on the morning line; if that price proves to be right she's a really nice second choice to have in the Exacta and Trifecta plans.

DONA CLOTA, winner of G1 events over 10 and 12 furlongs on dirt in her native Chile back in 2024, was unable to make an impact in the Glens Falls Stakes at Saratoga in early August, but this Saffie Joseph trainee is well worth a look as she goes for another stamina test. She improved to **Globeform 108** when capturing the Robert Dick Memorial Stakes over 11 furlongs at Delaware Park in June, taking the race by a neck from last year's Long Island Stakes winner Alluring Angel with a good kick from off the pace. Dona Clota was coming off a sixth placed finish in the 9-furlong Modesty at Churchill Downs (won by future G1 winner Kathrynmarissa) and the step back up in distance clearly suited her. She ran a good race also when third in the 11-furlong The Very One Stakes at Gulfstream Park back in February. This 5yo daughter of Ivan Denisovich has never raced at Kentucky Downs though her trainer has had a lot of success here and Dona Clota is an experienced horse who has run well over different courses. She's not the most consistent of horses but her best form gives her a chance and she will stay the trip. Having Jose Ortiz on board helps her chances but hurts the price. >>

CONCLUSION: Predicting a repeat of last year's exacta is hardly original, but that's what seems most likely to happen. Stellify probably won't get much pressure if she's sent to the lead (as can be expected) and Way to Be Marie has shown herself to be just as good in '26 as she was last year - so she becomes the obvious B-horse. It's rather strange to see her as big as **10-1 on the morning line**. Surely that's a mistake. Hopefully it will prove to be close to what we see on the board as the gates open, as around 10-1 about this contender makes her an absolute value bet across the board / each-way. Which one would you like to have on your side if Stellify fails to fire? The answer is Way to Be Marie in this office. Anything over 5-1 would be worth taking. Dona Clota and Pin Up Betty are Trifecta contenders and players wanting to add another to that plan should consider 15-1 shot **VENENCIA**. It's been a while since we saw her best but her two best performances happened over 12 furlongs and this trip will be to her liking. She was a neck in front of Way to Be Marie when they ran second and third in the Keertana Stakes at Keeneland back in May.
