GLOBEFORM ANALYSIS

LUSH LIPS closed her 3yo campaign out with two valuable wins, and this Irish import could be in for an even better campaign this year. She will find herself on deeper waters than this when we get to the Grade One action, but what makes Lush Lips particularly interesting is that she matured and became settled in the fall; having pulled to hard in her earlier races. She beat Pretty Picture by half a length in the Mrs Reverse Stakes over 8.5 furlongs at Churchill Downs in November, seven weeks after having won the Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup over 9 furlongs at Keeneland. The Brendan Walsh trainee was ridden prominently in both of these races. She had looked fairly exposed going into Queen Elizabeth, but had more to offer; marked improvement made her an impressive 1 1/4-length winner from Laurelin, who suffered her first defeat after five straight wins, while Opulent Restraint was third 3/4 length further back. Lush Lips was strong coming down the lane, earning **Globeform 111** in the process. Laurelin franked the form by running second to Fionn in the Jockey Club Oaks a month later. Lush Lips was 8-1 at Keeneland and just a touch over 1-2 at Churchill Downs. The Honey Fox is her first run for for three months and we should not expect to see her 100% fit for this return, but she is probably going to be the one to beat even if not fully tuned up. >>>

CREVALLE D'ORO is coming off two solid performances at Gulfstream Park, the most recent a game runner-up effort in the Pegasus World Cup Filly & Mare Turf over 8.5 furlongs in late January, when she was beaten half a length by Destino d'Oro after coming with a good finish from off the pace. **MOVIN' ON UP** was third another half-length further back. Crevalle d'Oro did not have a smooth trip that day, still she managed to run close to her career best, **Globeform 107**, recorded as she landed the Suwannee River Stakes over a mile at the same venue a month earlier. That was her first start for trainer Jose D'Angelo. Held up in midfield, she was delivered with fine run coming down the lane and got up to beat **MOVIN' ON UP** by a head. Movin' On Up, winner of the Sand Springs last March, was having her first run since a disappointing run at Kentucky Downs last September; she has a good record at this venue and, like Crevalle d'Oro, she has the form to make her a Trifecta filler once more. Movin' On Up is also very consistent; she has been in the first three in seven of her eight most recent starts (the only miss happened at the tricky Kentucky Downs). >>>

PUBLIC DEFENDER was rather dull when beating just two of her nine rivals in the Endeavour Stakes at Tampa Bay Downs in January - but she deserves another chance at this level. She did not have the best of runs when third behind **CREVALLE D'ORO** and **MOVIN' ON UP** in the Suwannee River Stakes over a mile at Gulfstream Park in December. Coming off a nine-week break, the daughter of Constitution was too far back, raced a touch freely and was compromised; only to finish really well from off the pace to pass the post 3 1/4 lengths behind Crevalle d'Oro, who took the race by a head from Movin' On Up. With Crevalle d'Oro both running so well in the Pegasus World Cup Filly & Mare Turf, Public Defender's effort was confirmed; and she ran even better last year, when four straight wins were followed by a game fourth placed finish behind next out Cardinal Stakes winner Proctor Street in a good allowance heat over 8.5 furlongs at Keeneland. Beaten 1 1/4 lengths while spotting the winner 2lbs, Public Defender ran to GF 105 in that contest - despite being compromised by the moderate pace and pulling a bit through the first four furlongs. She had produced **Globeform 106** when strolling home by 5 lengths from King's River in a more strongly run allowance race over the same distance at Colonial Downs in August, and in between these runs she was an easy 2 3/4-length winner from Vehemente (also over 8.5 fur. at Colonial).

CLASSIC Q is another with form good enough to give her a chance of hitting the board, and her main asset is that she is flexible; she can go to the lead or she can be held up off the pace - though she was being used quite hard in 2025 and her run in the Pegasus World Cup Filly & Mare Turf was very disappointing.

CONCLUSION: There's plenty of pace in this field and Lush Lips ran her best races when ridden prominently, but she doesn't need the lead to be effective; in fact she's ideally suited by sitting just behind the leader. She has not run since November and may need the outing, in addition she has to spot her rivals a bit of weight - but she is more classy than any other and her class should tell. Crevalle d'Oro, who would love to see a strong pace in front of her, looks the main danger. There's a lot to like about her two runs for a new barn this winter and her last two in 2025 were also nice efforts. Irad Ortiz represents an upgrade in the saddle (not that Ruiz made any mistakes) but it also means that she will take a lot of money.

GLOBEFORM ANALYSIS

EXPENSIVE QUEEN is interesting in this race. Having only her third start since she joined Brendan Walsh from England, this well bred daughter of Lope de Vega improved to **Globeform 105** when winning over an extended mile on the Tapeta track at Gulfstream Park in January, a level that - with her nice weight - might make her the one to beat in the Al Stall Memorial. Seemingly a late developing type, she delivered a performance worthy of a stakes horse when taking a strong allowance race at Gulfstream. The 5yo daughter of Lope de Vega proved 2 1/2 lengths too good for G3 winner Vixen, who was followed home by minor stakes winners Spinning Colors and Malley moo. The contest was switched from turf to the Tapeta track due to rain, and Expensive Queen took very well to the surface; kicking home with a determined finish from just off the pace under jockey Luis Saez, who retains the ride this week. Her two preceding starts were also promising; she won an 8.5-furlong allowance race at Keeneland last April, and managed fourth behind Be Your Best in the 9-furlong Gamely Stakes at Santa Anita five weeks later. A \$266,000 purchase at the Arqana Deauville August Sale in 2022, she is a sister Antonia De Vega, who beat future Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Alpinista when capturing the 12-furlong Princess Royal Stakes at Newmarket as a four-year-old. Expensive Queen has never tried further than 9 furlongs though (her best form in England came over a mile), and this distance suits her. The likely pace scenario will also suit her and she has a nice post position. There's a lot to like about her as she steps back up in class after beating Vixen and she may represent good value in the betting (morning line not released as this preview goes out).

MEDORO beat **CUPIDS CRUSH** by 3/4 length as they were well clear of the third placed **LUCKY SPEECH** in the Marie Krantz Memorial over 8.5 furlongs at the Fair Grounds in January - and she will be well fancied to maintain the superiority here. It's far from certain that she will though, because Cupids Crush is now as much as 6lbs better off at the weights; in addition she is one of just two front-runners and could get a nice tactical advantage. Six pounds equals about three lengths over this distance. Based purely on the Krantz Memorial result the logical horse to take out of the race is Cupids Crush. However, this is not quite so straightforward. Whereas Medoro had run to **Globeform 108** on two earlier outings (winning the Osunitas Stakes and taking second in the Mabee Stakes at Del Mar), Cupids Crush did not have such form in the book going into the Krantz Memorial. The heavy favorite Medoro returned GF 107 and Cupids Crush, who went off at 27-1, improved to **Globeform 105**. Where did the improvement come from? Quite often in such case one can find an explanation when closely examining what has happened with the horse. When it comes to Cupids Crush one can disregard her two runs prior to the Krantz Memorial. She was eased in the Dowager Stakes (over 12 furlongs) and the distance was far too short for her when she next tried 5.5 furlongs. So, let's go three starts back; to a 10 3/4-length win in the 8.5-furlong Minnesota Distaff Turf Championship at Canterbury Park. It was a four-runner race at a venue where GF ratings are not compiled, and she was .05 favorite; but her runner-up was coming off a win and wide margin stroll like this should always be respected. Could she have performed to around GF 100 or better at Canterbury? It's not impossible though either way she was a game second to Medoro last time out; and she is weighted to reverse that form in the Al Stall Memorial.

FEATHER BOA was second in a G1 over a mile in South Africa back in 2023. Her US career has not really got going yet; she ran just once in 2024 (third in 6-furlong allowance race at Aqueduct) and twice in 2025; third in the 8-furlong Noble Damsel over the same course in October, then fifth in Suwannee River Stakes over 8 furlongs at Gulfstream Park, where she ran on from the back and was 5 3/4 lengths behind Crevalle d'Oro, who was second in the Pegasus World Cup Turf a month later. Feather Boa ran to GF 100 in the Noble Damsel, a couple of lengths below her career best. From what we have seen of her, she needs a strong pace to race effectively - and that's not the most likely scenario in this race.

SWEET TREASURE earned **Globeform 101p** by winning a mile allowance heat at Churchill Downs last October, and she was close to that rating also when third, 2 lengths behind Fast Market, in the Pebbles Stakes over 8.5 furlongs at Aqueduct the following month. Her first run this season was not so smooth; she finished sixth to **MEDORO** in the Marie Krantz Memorial after a poor trip. Her Churchill Downs success put her name in many an observer's notebook though; the Brad Cox trainee quickened well from just off the pace to beat Storm Miami 2 lengths, with next-out winner Golden Sunshine third (she runs in R8 at Turfway Park this Wednesday). Sweet Treasure may be open to improvement and she is a Trifecta horse. >>>

OVERSUBSCRIBED, representing Chad Brown's team, is likely to take money at the windows, probably more than her form actually justifies. Coming off a half-length win over Mallemoo (who was beaten 7 3/4 lengths behind **EXPENSIVE QUEEN** on her next start) in the 8.5-furlong Forever Together Stakes at Aqueduct in November, she should be respected but this daughter of top class miler Too Darn Hot is not your typical 'Chad slam dunk'. Aged five, she has had an interrupted career with three wins from just seven runs and her form makes her a good fit in this race - though almost certainly as poor value. The way she won the Forever Together indicated that she wouldn't mind trying longer distances.

CONCLUSION: Expensive Queen did not win her allowance race in the powerful or smooth way that tells us we are looking at a runner sure to improve further down the road; but she could well improve and even if she doesn't she has a strong winning chance in this contest. She's the selection, while Medoro (game, consistent and reliable) and Cupids Crush (who can prove her good run last time was no fluke) deserve to be ranked equally - alongside Oversubscribed, who is 6-for-7 in the top three. Sweet Treasure appeals as a filly with more to give than what's been revealed thus far.
