FLORIDA DERBY CONTENDER CHIEF WALLABEE IN FOCUS

CHIEF WALLABEE is a barnmate to last year's undisputed champion Sovereignty 3yo - who ran second in the Florida Derby - and this is an interesting contender for Gulfstream Park's main Kentucky Derby prep. This will be only his third start and, although he is set to clash with Commandment once more, the waters *are* going to be a bit deeper here. The 9-furlong distance is also a new factor, but that will be the same for Commandment and Nearly too. At this stage of the season we always ask the question 'which one will improve the most'? As Chief Wallabee has raced just twice, he's probably the one who can take the biggest step up. Though at the same time he is the one with only limited experience. He improved markedly from his impressive debut when almost winning the Fountain of Youth over 8.5 furlongs at this venue in February; running to **Globeform 110p** as he went

down by a neck to Commandment, who caught him close home and won by a neck while spotting the Bill Mott trainee 2lbs. The two were virtually upsides as the field went into the home turn, where Chief Wallabee's rider had no option but to go wide - while Commandment was in the right spot for a rail trip. He was off the bridle and Chief Wallabee, who hit the front early in the short stretch, looked the most likely winner. That was not to be, however; the inside opened up for Commandment, who gained momentum and stayed on the strongest to be a worthy winner. See more on this race in Commandment's bio. He seems sure to appreciate this step up in distance, and he will like that this race goes to the second winning post - whereas Chief Wallabee is not at all guaranteed to stay.

He confirmed the impression of being a high class colt given on his debut, and the form of that race has also been franked since. Chief Wallabee beat The Puma comfortably by 1 3/4 lengths over 7 furlongs at Gulfstream Park in January. He sat just off the pace, traveling well all the way, and picked up like good horse when asked by his rider inside the final furlong. His runner-up did put up a fight but he had no chance as the two were well clear of the rest. The Puma went on to be third in the Sam F. Davis Stakes at Tampa Bay Downs. He was beaten 6 lengths behind Renegade in that contest, but found a bit of home stretch trouble and could have been closer. A month later he captured the Tampa Bay Derby, beating last year's Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes winner Further Ado by a head. To summarize; Chief Wallabee has had an unusual start to his career - meeting graded stakes winners in both of his two first starts. Undoubtedly talented, the question he now needs to answer is regarding distance. The way he won first time out one would probably mark him down as a future stakes winner over a mile - and didn't Commandment beat him for stamina in the Fountain of Youth?

A son of Florida Derby winner Constitution, Chief Wallabee is out of the unraced Medaglia d'Oro mare A La Lucie. Her dam, Glorzyapper, was a G3 winner over 6.5 furlongs at Santa Anita as a 3yo, when she also ran second in a Listed event over 8.5 furlongs. Chief Wallabee's third dam, Grand Glory, was operating at a much lower level; her only win came in a mile maiden at Beulah Park. She was a daughter of Royally Chosen, whose best results came when she ran second to in the 7-furlongs La Brea Stakes at three and in the 8.5-furlong Bayakoa Handicaps at six. A minor stakes winner from 7 to 8.5 furlongs, she was also more about speed than stamina. >>>

GULFSTREAM
PARK

Any staying power making Chief Wallabee a live Kentucky Derby contender must come from his sire. Constitution was very good over 9 furlongs at Gulfstream Park, winning the Florida Derby at three and the Donn Handicap at four. He missed the Triple Crown series and his only run over 10 furlongs was a career ending last of six in the Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park, where something was clearly amiss him. His son Tiz the Law also took the Florida Derby; then won the 10-furlong Belmont Stakes and ran second in the September Kentucky Derby in 2020. Mindframe, who captured the Churchill Downs Stakes over 7 furlongs and the Stephen Foster Stakes over 9 furlongs last year, is also a son of Constitution. He ran second both in the 10-furlong Belmont and the 9-furlong Haskell Invitational as a three-year-old. Mindframe is out of a daughter of Street Sense, while Tiz the Law's dam was by Tiznow. Both of these broodmare sires were top class performers with stamina, as was Chief Wallabee's broodmare sire Medaglia d'Oro.

One race only was recommended as a good betting opportunity on Louisiana Derby day
It's called selective wagering

CONCLUSION: Lagynos has an obvious chance; he has never been better than in his last race, and he can become another to complete the Fair Grounds Stakes / Muniz Memorial Stakes double. However, he has to give 4lbs to Program Trading, and that could prove difficult. If Program Trading runs back to his best form of last year (GF 113), well, then Lagynos will need GF 117 to match strides with the Chad Brown runner. Thus, it's not hard to side with Program Trading either, but this isn't quite that simple. While Lagynos has clearly been pointed at these winter / spring Fair Grounds races and is in top shape, Program Trading probably comes here in order to get a run under his belt before he steps back up to G1 events like the Turf Classic on Kentucky Derby Day and the Manhattan on Belmont day. Those are his main targets and he might not be at peak fitness as we are still in March. Another factor is that a (likely) moderate pace will not inconvenience Lagynos all that much. The Asmussen candidate gets the vote in this office. Chasing the Crown, Montador and Tom's Magic have about an equal chance; and a low cost Trifecta plan must be to us Lagynos as the winner with Program Trading 2nd / 3rd with those three included. That's just 6 lines and the back-up ticket can be a 3-liner with Program Trading to win from Lagynos with the other three in third spot.
