GLOBEFORM ANALYSIS

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY and **PARADISE LAKE** ran second and third respectively in the 11-furlong Red Carpet Stakes at Del Mar in late November, beaten a neck and 1 1/2 lengths by the hot favorite Mrs. Astor. 44-1 chance **SUN OF HILL** finished fourth and the 3yo Will Then - who ran third in the American Oaks on Sunday - filled fifth, beaten 3 lengths after setting the pace. Public Assembly is likely to do best again in this race. Never far off the pace and saving ground by the rail, she finished the Red Carpet off in a game manner, tough had no chance when Mrs. Astor came with her late kick. She was value for more than the neck margin but she is also the one who is best suited by 11 furlongs (she win the race also in 2024).

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY improved to **Globeform 105** in the Red Carpet and she could be capable of better still now back over a shorter trip. Not that she is void of stamina. She broke her maiden over 10.5 furlongs at the demanding Kentucky Downs course last year and she won a 10-furlong allowance race at Santa Anita in March (beating next out 3-length winner Kentucky Gal). Her versatility then made her a solid 1 3/4-length winner from **SUN OF THE HILL** in the Royal Heroine Stakes over a mile; and her runs in the Yellow Ribbon (staying on second to Heredia) and Mabee Stakes (fourth to Gimme a Nother) were performances at the same level; while a mile at Del Mar was too sharp when she checked in sixth behind Special Wan in the Goldikova Stakes three weeks prior to the Red Carpet. The competition was too hot and her performance in the Goldikova was better than it appears on paper; and she ran a winning race last time out - but simply met a better filly in Mrs. Astor. With decent form also over turf courses with a bit of give Public Assembly may not be troubled by any rain, and this 4yo daughter of More Than Ready holds strong claims here.

PARADISE LAKE has also produced consistent form lately, and - being 2lbs better off at the weights - she's in with a chance of making a race of it with Public Assembly. Unlike Public Assembly. She ran fifth 2 lengths behind **PUBLIC ASSEMBLY** over 10 furlongs at Santa Anita in March and her three runs over 8.5 and 9 furlongs since all indicated that a step up in distance was well worth a try; but attempting 11 furlongs did not bring out improvement in the Red Carpet. She ran to **Globeform 100**, the same mark she had returned when winning on her previous outing. A lightly raced 4yo daughter of Uncle Mo, Paradise Lake finished strongly from off the pace to beat the favorite Certitude by 3/4 length covering nine panels at Santa Anita in October. Certitude next ran third to Princesa Moche in a similar contest at Del Mar. Princesa Moche was then coming off a win at Santa Anita. These fomlines give Paradise Lake's record a solid look, all of her three wins have been here at Santa Anita, and she must be respected.

WATCHTOWER is the interesting one to give us a chance of a good Trifecta / Superfecta plan. Coming off an 11-week break, she has form good enough to make her a player in this contest. She was exiting a longer break when producing her career best form in the Yellow Ribbon Handicap over 8.5 furlongs at Del Mar in early August, when she made up ground from the back to finish third, beaten 2 1/4 lengths and a nose behind the G1 placed Euro import Heredia and **PUBLIC ASSEMBLY**. Heredia made all at a slow pace and Public Assembly was sitting just a few lengths behind the leader. The way the race developed, they both had a definite tactical edge over Watchtower, who would have been better suited by stronger fractions. She was second last and in a bit of vacuum, causing her to race a bit freely as she had no cover. She was forced to go wide coming out of the home bend and did well to get as close as she did, recording **Globeform 104** in the process. She meets Public Assembly as 2lbs better terms today and it's not impossible that she can beat her. The one problem is, however, that this is also a race that lacks pace. Watchtower has since been fifth in the One Dreamer Stakes at Kentucky Downs (ran to GF 102), been pulled up due to a slipping saddle in the 10-furlong Rodeo Drive and a below par sixth in the 8-furlong Swingtime Stakes (both at Santa Anita). Whereas her main rivals today seem to be 'adding one more race' to their 2205 campaigns, Watchtower may have been laid out specifically for the Frankel Stakes. At **5-1 on the morning line**, this Richard Baltas trainee is actually bordering on being worth recommending as a value bet. Keep an eye on the board; she could well go off at bigger odds and thus worth an across the board / ew wager.

SUN OF HILL stayed on from well off the pace in the Red Carpet, but it's well worth noting that her best rating, **Globeform 103**, was achieved when she ran second, 1 3/4 lengths behind **PUBLIC ASSEMBLY** while spotting her 4lbs in the Royal Heroine Stakes over a mile back in April. Sun Of Hill finished strongly from the back also on that occasion and a lively pace would suit her best in the Robert Frankel - but that's unlikely to happen. >>>

WILLA T, who has produced progressive form in three straight wins, is the most interesting of the three added to the Frankel field after the postponement. This late developing daughter of Oscar Performance actually won with ease when gaining a neck verdict over the Irish import Miss Meagher in a mile allowance heat at Del Mar in late November. Coming with a smooth run from just off the pace, Willa T won quite cheekily and she improved to **Globeform 96p**, having run to to GF 90p to beat With Love by a nose over the same distance at Santa Anita a month earlier (when she hit the front too early and idled). Looking at Willa T's most recent start, we see that her runner-up Miss Meagher was exiting a last of five effort behind **I'M A JOKER** in October - but Miss Meagher had produced better form than that showing more than once in earlier races (including in Ireland). Willa T is set to try 9 furlongs for the first time here. She is a half-sister to a 10-furlong stakes winner in Panama and a moderate 5.5-furlong winner in the US - so her pedigree is not too helpful - but let's focus on her running style; he has been racing like a horse capable of going further than a mile. Well drawn in stall two, and being one of just two runners with good tactical speed, she is in with a chance and **8-1 morning line is too big**.

CONCLUSION: This could easily develop into a race between Public Assembly and Paradise Lake, the duo that filled second and third behind Mrs. Astor in the Red Carpet Stakes at Del Mar. Recent form is one way to look at this but the pace scenario, i.e. moderate, is another and it's likely to favor Public Assembly. Another runner it would suit just as well however, is Tim Yakteen's Willa T. A fresh horse taking a shot at a G3 after a comfortable allowance win, she is open to further improvement and 8-1 is not a bad price for this contender. She does not have the same credentials as the top two but they are somewhat exposed and - based on ratings - the gap up from her best form to what will be needed here isn't all that big. Also note how well Yakteen's team has been doing recently. Their last 50 starters have produced 9 winners and 14 horses getting second or third. That's a healthy 46% top three record. Add in the fact that Willa T is 7-for-9 in the first three in her light career and it's even more tempting to go with this **8-1 shot**. Why not? Let's take a chance. After all, this mare is both a live win contender and the field's best value bet option. Tri plan suggestion: Use Willa T in 1st, 2nd and 3rd with a few others.
